2-Amino adipic 2-Oxo adipic Aciduria

2-Amino adipic 2-Oxo adipic Aciduria is a rare metabolic disorder characterised by high levels of compounds known as 2-oxoadipate and 2-hydroxyadipate in the urine, and elevated levels of the compound 2-amino adipate in the blood. This is a genetic disorder that is linked to a defect in the normal breakdown of the essential amino acid lysine in the body. Most individuals with this condition do not show any symptoms.
