Arts Syndrome is an extremely rare disorder which is characterised by serious neurological problems, sensorineural deafness, sight loss, muscle weakness, ataxia, developmental delay and intellectual disabilities as well as a high susceptibility to recurrent infections. This condition affects males, and although females can have the condition, their symptoms are much milder.
